Dear Assoc. Prof. Dr Nguyen Thanh Phong.

l am writing to advise you of the upcoming commencement of Australia's new Wine Export Licensing and Approval System, and minor associated changes to Australia's certification for wine exports to Viet Nam.

Wine Australia (Australia's wine export regulator) is implementing a new system upgrade to ensure that all documents that it produces include its new name, changing from 'Australian Grape and Wine Authority' to 'Wine Australia'. Please be assured that the regulator remains the same and that there has been no change to certification conditions. Attachment A provides examples of the new certificates issued by Wine Australia.

The rollout of the new certificates is expected to commence this month and be completed by the end of August 2020. During this time, Wine Australia will issue both the existing export certification and the new export certification. Border inspection officials will see both the existing and the new certificates until all consignments in transit have cleared import inspection.

Wine Australia will also eventually be moving away from producing 'wet ink' stamped certificates and will begin generating certificates with electronic signatures and stamps. We will inform our trading partners of the phase-out date once this functionality is available in the system.

l would appreciate your assistance in communicating the commencement date of the new Wine Export Licensing and Approval System and transition arrangements across relevant areas of your agency as appropriate and also to Vietnam ports.



Tôi gửi ông thư này để thông báo về sự thay đổi sắp tới trong hệ thống Phê duyệt và Cấp giấy phép Rượu vang xuất khẩu của Úc, cũng như là một số thay đổi trong giấy chứng nhận dành cho rượu xuất khẩu sang Việt Nam.

Ngành công nghiệp rượu vang Úc (các nhà xuất khẩu rượu vang Úc) đang áp dụng một hệ thống mới được nâng cấp để đảm bảo rằng trên tất cả các tài liệu liên quan đến sản phẩm, sẽ có tên gọi mới , thay đổi từ 'Cơ quan quản lý Nho và Rượu vang của Úc' (Tiếng Anh: 'Australian Grape and Wine Authority') thành 'Cơ quan Rượu vang Úc' (Tiếng Anh: 'Wine Australia'). Chúng tôi xin đảm bảo rằng chức năng của cơ quan vẫn như cũ và không có thay đổi về điều kiện cấp giấy chứng nhận. Tài liệu đính kèm A cung cấp các ví dụ về các mẫu giấy chứng nhận theo mẫu mới do Cơ quan Rượu vang Úc cấp.

Việc triển khai các giấy chứng nhận theo mẫu mới dự kiến sẽ bắt đầu trong tháng Năm này và sẽ hoàn thành vào cuối tháng 8/2020. Trong giai đoạn này, Cơ quan Rượu vang Úc sẽ cấp cả chứng thư xuất khẩu hiện tại và chứng thư xuất khẩu theo mẫu mới. Các cán bộ kiểm tra tại biên giới sẽ thấy cả chứng thư theo mẫu hiện tại và chứng thư theo mẫu mới cho đến khi tất cả các lô hàng quá cảnh đã được hoàn tất việc kiểm tra nhập khẩu.

Cơ quan Rượu vang Úc sẽ dần không sử dụng chứng thư có dấu mực tươi và sẽ bắt đầu cấp các chứng thư sử dụng chữ ký điện tử và con dấu. Chúng tôi sẽ thông báo cho các đối tác thương mại về ngày hết hiệu lực của chứng thư sử dụng dấu mực một khi chức năng này có sẵn trong hệ thống.

Tôi trông đợi sự hỗ trợ từ phía ông trong việc thông tin cho các phòng ban có liên quan cũng như là Hải quan Việt Nam về ngày bắt đầu của hệ thống Phê duyệt và Cấp giấy phép Xuất khẩu rượu mới.



#### Wine Australia Regulations 2018

Wine Australia is a statutory authority of the Australian Government established under the provisions of the *Wine Australia Act 2013* (the Act). The Act and the Wine Australia Regulations 2018 define the objects of the Act and the functions of the Authority.

The above Regulations provide that the export of a defined grape product from Australia is prohibited unless certain prescribed criteria are met. The conditions state:

- The exporter must be licensed.
- When requested, the licensee must provide samples for the purpose of determining the soundness and merchantability of the grape product.

It is a condition of export that:

- The product must comply with the Australian Food Standards Code in respect to both labelling and analytical requirements;
   and
- The product must comply with the Wine Australia Regulations 2018 in respect to the blending requirements for any vintage, varietal, or geographical Indication claimed on the label.
- · If an "organic" claim is made, the product satisfies the requirements of Australia's export control orders regarding such claims.

This is to certify that free sale of the wine listed above is permitted in Australia (subject to State Licensing Laws) and that the wines have been granted an export permit from Wine Australia on the basis that the above criteria have been met.
